

PARAPHRASE THE SENTENCES TO MAKE THE SECOND OR THIRD CONDITIONAL

[Exercise 2]

Paraphrase the sentences as in the example to make **Conditional sentence — type 2 or type 3**. Mind the punctuation.

Example:

Ryan works every day, so he is tired.

Answer:

If Ryan **did not work** every day, he **would not be** tired.

OR

Example:

I sprained my ankle, so I didn't play in the last match.

Answer:

If I **had not sprained** my ankle, I **would have played** in the last match.
