[Exercise 1]

Paraphrase the sentences as in the example to make **Conditional sentence — type 3**. Mind the punctuation.

Example:

We did not cooked dinner yesterday, so we ordered pizza.

Answer:

If we had cooked dinner yesterday, we would not have ordered pizza.

2. I did not turn on the light, so I fell over.
