| 5 | shut down | E | to rise to a standing position after sitting or lying down |
| 6 | shut up | F | to continue to do something |

| 8 | fill in | H | to stop vehicle (car, bus, van, etc.) usually for a short time |
| 9 | pull up | I | to move, progress or increase at the same rate or speed as somebody else |
