| <b>1</b>  | turn out  | <b>A</b> | to stop competing or arguing and accept that you cannot win  |
| <b>2</b>  | turn over | <b>B</b> | to be known or discovered finally and surprisingly   |
| <b>3</b>  | turn up   | <b>C</b> | to stop a piece of equipment working temporarily by pressing a button or by moving a switch          |
| <b>4</b>  | turn down | <b>D</b> | to return something to its original owner/provider   |
| <b>5</b>  | turn off  | <b>E</b> | to increase the volume or level of something   |
| <b>6</b>  | turn back | <b>F</b> | to give something to several people  |
| <b>7</b>  | give up   | <b>G</b> | to stop doing something that you do regularly  |
| <b>8</b>  | give back | <b>H</b> | to turn something such as a page in a book or a sheet of paper so that the other side is towards you |
| <b>9</b>  | give out  | <b>I</b> | to refuse (not to accept) something such as request, offer, opportunity, etc.                        |
| <b>10</b> | give in   | <b>J</b> | to turn around so as to face the opposite direction  |
